## CV Heidi Bucher

### Vita

1926

born as Adelheid Hildegard Müller (later Heidi Bucher) in Winterthur, Switzerland

1956

moves to New York, managing the legendary World House Gallery on Madison Avenue

1958

exhibits her silk collages and drawings in New York and developed friendly contacts with such people as photographer Hans Namuth and the Cobra artist Karel Appel

1960 – 1963

After returning to Zurich in 1960, she met and married the artist Carl Bucher. Indigo Bucher was born in 1961, Mayo in 1963. Their flat and studio quickly became an open house. Many interesting personalities of that period – such as the artist Max Bill, the gallerist Bruno Bischofsberger, the critics Erika and Fritz Billeter and Willy Rotzler – were frequent friends.

1969

The family moved first to Montreal, and then to Toronto for a year (with a fellowship granted by the Canadian government to Carl Bucher).

1970 – 1973

Performances by Heidi Bucher and exhibitions by Carl Bucher led the family to California (Hollywood Hills and Santa Barbara) before they finally returned to Switzerland via Canada in 1973. Among the works produced in California were „Bodyshells“ and „Wrappings“ by Heidi Bucher, which were shown as exhibitions in Los Angeles County Museum of Art and the Esther Bear Gallery in Santa Barbara.

1973

The family returned to Switzerland. Heidi Bucher rented an old butcher's shop and a flat in Weinbergstrasse, Zurich, a spacious basement with five separate rooms. Heidi and Carl went their separate ways.

1973 – 1978

Bucher makes her earliest „Häutungen“ (skinnings), which she exhibited for the first time in 1977 with other works described as „Einbalsamierungen“ (embalmings) in the Galerie Maeght in Zurich.

diagnosis of an incurable tumor
